Under the direction of Lori Turner, the Renaissance Youth Opera Theatre (better known as RYOT) proudly presents two well-known tales of adventure! In the 1858 Illinois Senate race, as the country steamrolled towards an enormous and costly civil war, Abraham Lincoln and Stephen Douglas embarked on a series of debates. Their epic clash of ideas and oratory forged a future President and a nation. *The Rivalry* is a riveting recreation of the debates and the topics that are still relevant today.

This production features Robert Parsons, who starred in

the acclaimed production of *The Rivalry* at Ford's Theatre in Washington last year and who will recreate the role of Abraham Lincoln. 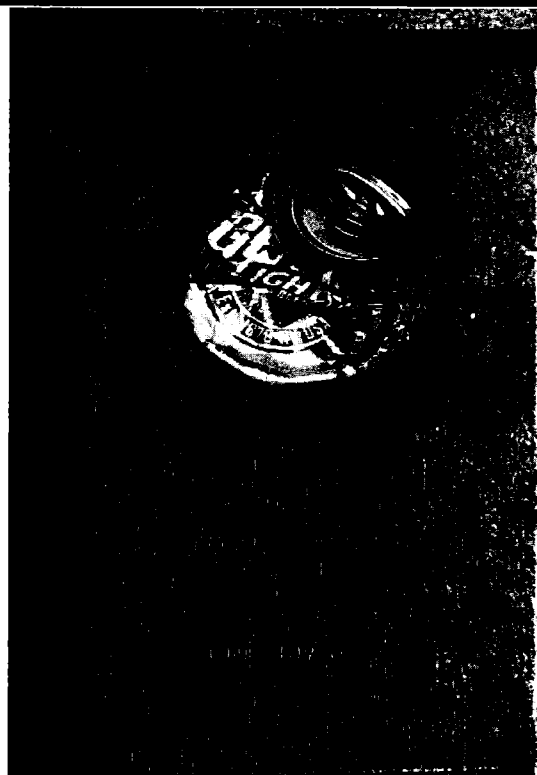
